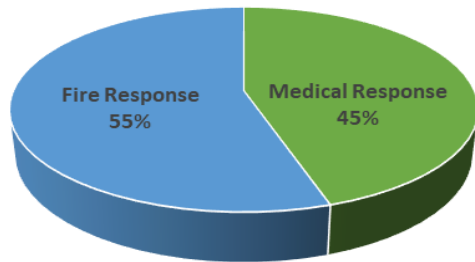


Village of Alix Year in Review 2022

The Alix Fire Department answered a total of 190 calls in the last year. 87 of those were to provide medical assistance with an average of 3 First Responders attending each call. They put in a total of 226 hours and 25 minutes of volunteer time on medical response calls.

Emergency Management

Alix Emergency Management took part in a full scale emergency exercise to test our local and regional response plans. This exercise included 13 communities, 200 actors, 240 community staff, 500 eyes on exercise, and 600 simulated evacuees!

Municipal Affairs Performance Measures

Since 2017, Municipal Affairs has collected information from every municipality regarding 13 “performance measures”. These 13 financial and governance categories are monitored to determine if a town or village is viable and thriving or having difficulty and possibly in need of dissolving. We’re happy to say the Village of Alix received a letter from Municipal Affairs stating they are **“pleased to inform you that your municipality did not flag any indicators for this year’s Municipal Indicator Results report.”**

Gator Park—Gator Park is now the only fully accessible park in the Village, with a level concrete surface making it safe for those with mobility issues to enjoy as well as other residents and guests to the community. This project was 75% grant funded.
