

## Village of Alix Fire Department Statistics


The Alix Fire Department answered a total of 135 calls, 51 fire calls and 84 medical calls.

The Village partnered with the new **Alix and Area Community Resource Centre**, to bring much needed services to the Village. The Centre is located in Bay # 1 - 5008 50 Avenue in Railway House. The Centre is open Monday-Thursday, 10 am to 4 pm (closed on statutory holidays).

Three (3) new businesses opened their doors and a total of 52 business licenses were sold this year.

New 24-hour gas and diesel pumps were installed at the Gas Plus & Convenience Store on Highway 12.

**A**mendments to the Land-Use Bylaw were passed in 2020.

The campground remained open at half- capacity for most of the 2020 season.

The roads on the north-side of Hwy 12 received chip sealing this year, and will get a second coat in 2021. The project came in \$16,000 under budget!

- ⇒ Alix Cutter Poker Rally had another very successful event at the Ag Grounds.
