BYLAW NO. 476/23

BEING A Bylaw of the Village of Alix in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of closing public travel and disposing of a portion of a public highway in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1, Revised Statutes Of Alberta 2000, as amended.

WEHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WEHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WEHEREAS the Council of the Village of Alix deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and therefore disposing of same, and

WEHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and public notices were mailed to all

residents of Alix on January 20, 2023

WEHEREAS Council <u>ωαs not</u> petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE, that the Council of the Village of Alix in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of disposing of the following section of described highway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

All that portion of 45th Street contiguous with Lots 1 – 3; Block L; Plan 5676 AE

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals
