



### **Critical Worker Benefit**

Deadline has been extended to August 21st, 2021

The Critical Worker Benefit provides a one-time payment of \$1,200 to eligible Albertans in recognition of their hard work to provide Albertans with the care and critical services they need.

A second phase of the program is open and new categories of workers in the social services and private sectors are now eligible.

## The Canada Recovery Hiring Program

The Canada Recovery Hiring Program provides a subsidy on eligible salary or wages to help hard-hit businesses hire the workers they need to recover and grow as local economies reopen.

This program allows eligible employers to hire new workers, increase workers' hours, or increase wages at a pace that works for them. As with the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy, eligible employers can apply for support after each fourweek period of the program.

We are ensuring that businesses can continue to get the financial support they need to invest in their longer-term prosperity, including businesses in hard-hit sectors like tourism and hospitality, hotels, arts, and entertainment.

Work Sharing Program – this is a program that helps employers and employees avoid layoffs when there is a temporary decrease in business activity beyond the control of the employers. This will provide Employment Insurance (EI) benefits to eligible employees who agree to reduce their normal working hours and share the available work while their employer recovers.
