

VILLAGE OF ALIX 2022 BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL

Business Licenses must be purchased by January 31st, 2022

FEES:

Local Businesses - \$50

Non-local Businesses - \$100

A business license term runs from January to December 31st in each calendar year.

As per BYLAW 379/09 of the Village of Alix "No person shall within or partly within the Village of Alix corporate limits:

- i) carry on any business or;
- ii) carry on any
 undertaking or
 do any act or
 use or have any
 article, for which
 a license is
 required"

Business licenses can be issued at the Village office



COMING SOON

REP Implementation Grant: A one-time payment of \$2000 to eligible Alberta small and medium sized business who are eligible for and choose to implement the Restrictions Exemptions Program. Full eligibility criteria and application details will be shared once finalized.

REP Training Grant: Eligible industry associations will be able to access funding to develop or produce safety training that helps workers assess and manage challenging situations when implementing the restriction Exemptions Program. Worker and employers will be able to access this training through select industry associations.
