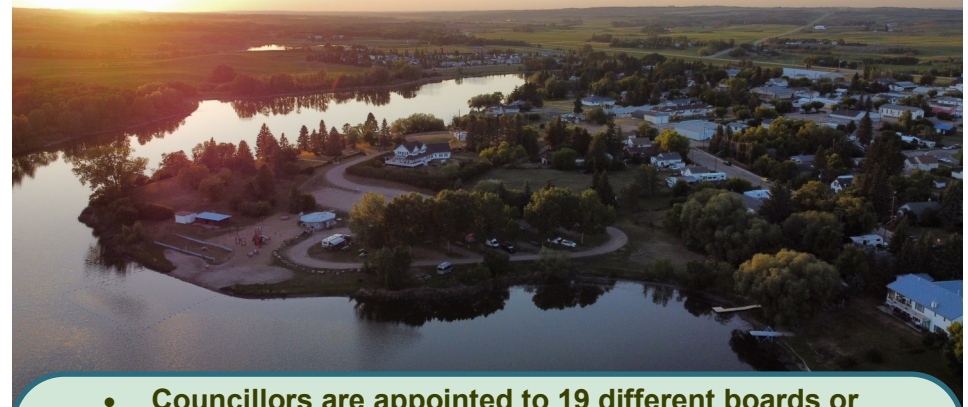

Lake Dredging

Phase 2 of lake dredging was completed this summer. A larger more central location of the lake was chosen for Phase 2 to have all the vegetation and sludge removed.

Approximately **3,100 m³** was removed from the bottom of the lake. Phase 2 cost \$302,000.01 and was funded from tax dollars.

With the completion of Phases 1 and 2 we have, for the second year, been blue-green algae FREE.

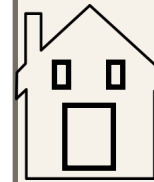
